Position: The Elementary School Physical Activity Project Coordinator will be hired as a contracted position and will be responsible for managing and planning, program implementation for the technology based recess innovative program, as well as physical activity programs during the school day for the K-5 student population. The position will also be responsible for research based data collection and assist with program evaluation for the Community Transformation Grant (CTG) funded through the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. This position will work with and be supervised by the CTG Program Manager and will work with the Program Evaluator.

Qualifications: Must have a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree or higher with an area of concentration in psychology, pediatric psychology, behavioral psychology, research, or related fields. The position will also require a strong background in computer and innovative technology.
